Workshop Goals and Purpose

Carbon cycle management is essential to mitigating the worst effects of climate change. Understanding the processes of land surface changes and carbon cycling in coupled and dynamic modeling requires a more concerted effort to integrate data and results across the natural and social sciences. Quantifying the carbon consequences of specific land use and management activities is critical to implementing consistent mechanisms for encouraging sequestration and discouraging emissions.

The purpose of this workshop is to bring together scientists in land use/land cover change science and carbon cycle science to share research results, identify uncertainties, caucus on approaches to reduce those uncertainties, and to foster collaboration in land use/land cover change and carbon studies across traditional disciplinary lines.
